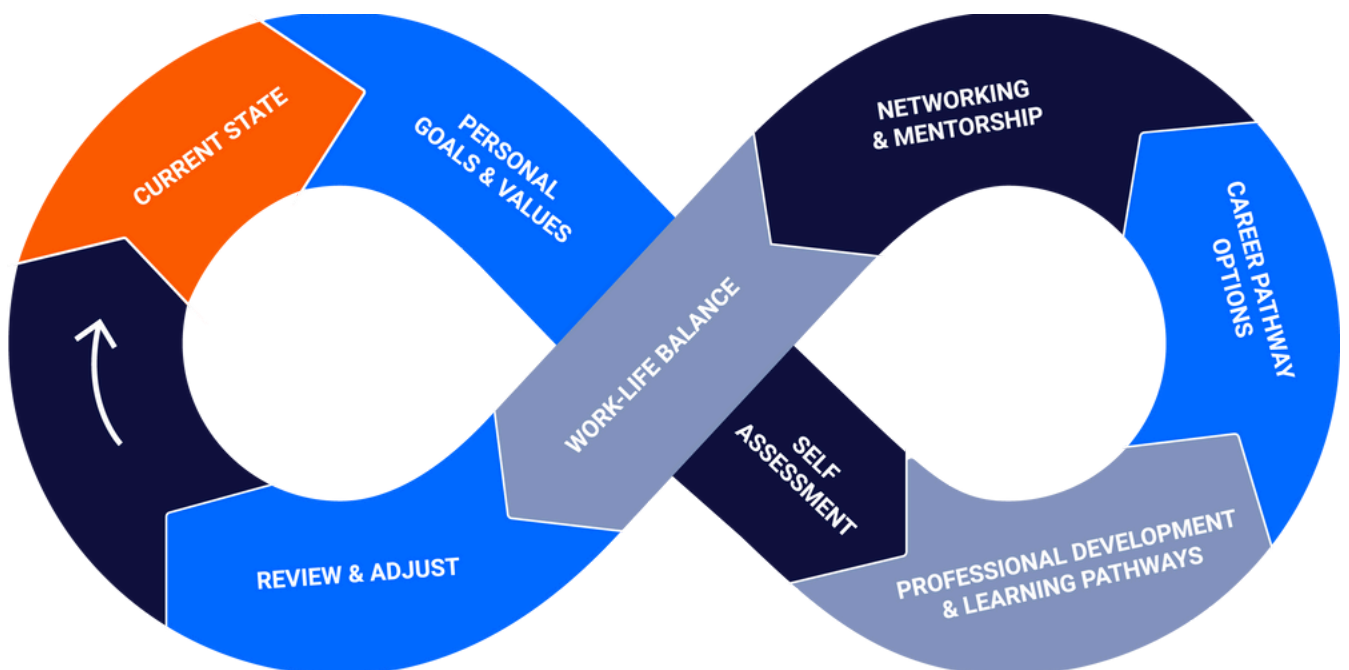

# A Step by Step Process for Planning Your Future

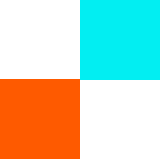
## HOW TO USE THE PLAN:

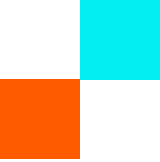
# What is my current state?

*For example - compassion - showing empathy to people I engage with, or integrity - emphasizing the importance of honesty & ethical decision-making.*

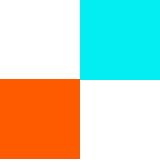

Identify areas of strength and aspects needing improvement, using tools like SWOT analysis.
